





Captain Jorgen Amorim has worked in the shipping industry since 1963, His seagoing career included sailing as Chief Officer and Master on oil and chemical tankers in various shipping companies .

Since coming ashore in 1997 Captain Amorim gained extensive experience as Q.A Manager, technical superintendent, Technical Manager and Fleet Manager. He has been heavily involved in the supervision of new buildings (oil and chemical tankers) in Turkey and Korea as well as converting a general cargo vessel to a highly specialized chemical tanker for the carriage of hydrochloric acid. Since 2007 Captain Amorim has primarily been involved as a marine consultant conducting technical inspections of various types of vessels, such as oil tankers, chemical tankers, general cargo ships, reefer ships and bulk carriers. He is an experienced Flag State inspector with a deep insight in practical and regulatory issues relating ship operations, ship management, shipyards, class, Flag State, etc.

Captain Amorim is an accredited and active CDI inspector and regularly conducts P&I condition surveys.
